Maths:

- In Maths, the children will be learning how to subtract numbers within twenty, crossing the ten. We are exploring different structures of subtraction: taking away, partitioning and finding the difference.
- The children will also be finding addition and subtraction fact families for numbers within 20, recognising that addition and subtraction are inverse operations.

English:

- In English, we will be using a new spelling rule for adding -s or -es to words. The children will be applying this skill to continue to write their innovated story. We will also be introducing 'exclamation marks'.

Topic:

- We will learn about the human body. We will draw around our body, identify, name and label the basic parts. We will also visit the animals at Woodrush to consolidate all our learning about animals so far this half term. We are looking forward to seeing the animals!
