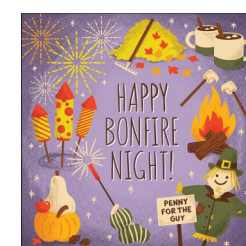
Children in Need Day- visit from Pudsey.
