This week we are learning:

- **Maths:** The children will continue to subtract numbers, within 20, crossing the 10. We will continue to use the subtraction symbol and concrete resources and pictorial methods.
- **English:** Continuing to orally rehearse The Queen's Hat story, using our new actions. To begin to learn about the exclamation mark and use it to punctuate sentences. To independently write and spell sentences containing the er and est suffix e.g. higher, tallest.
- **History:** The children will learn about Charles I and the time where there was no King and Queen in England.
- **Art:** The children will be appraising the work of Paul Klee, focusing on his painting 'The Castle and the Sun'.

World Book Day:

We invite children to come to school on the 5th March in pyjamas and dressing gowns and to bring a favourite book with them. They can also bring slippers, a cushion and/or a teddy. This is to ensure that part of the day can be used for cosy reading for pleasure. In contrast to previous years, we will not be asking for children to dress up as characters this year. There will be no charge for this non-uniform day: we warmly encourage parents, if you're able to, to spend any money that would've previously bought costumes, on books for your child/ren instead. If children don't want to come in their pyjamas/dressing gown, they can choose to come in school uniform. If the children do come to school wearing their cosy clothes, it is important that you ensure that they have a coat and appropriate footwear for break and lunch times.
