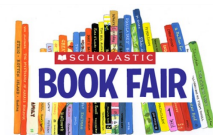
## This week we are learning:

*If you are self-isolating, this is an outline of this weeks learning you can join in with at home.*

- **Maths:** The children will be counting forwards and backwards to 50 (use the 100 square in Communication Books). We will also be representing numbers within 50 identifying tens and ones to support their understanding of place value. At home practise counting forwards and backwards <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YtNskltyAOE>. This website allows children to represent a number using base 10. <https://apps.mathlearningcenter.org/number-pieces/>. Place Value Basketball numbers up to 49 match the number and base 10 <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/place-value-basketball>.
- **English:** This week the children will be innovating the story of The Queen's Hat by changing the item and settings. We will also begin to start writing our shared story. At home children are encouraged to write a sentence using a picture from <https://www.onceuponapicture.co.uk/> use your Communication Book for the handwriting lines.
