Reading in Year 1

All children will be be coming home on Monday 14th September with a reading folder containing a reading book, diary and a set of keywords.



These folders will go home on a Monday and <u>must</u> be returned on a Friday. Please bear with us while we assess the children and match the books to their levels, we welcome your feedback in their reading diary.

Children will receive one reading book per week (on Monday), these will not be changed during the week. If you do not return your reading book on Friday, unfortunately, you will have to wait until the following week to have the book changed. This is due to us having to 'quarantine' books in between uses.

You will also receive a Bug Club log in on Friday, where children will be assigned online reading books and phonics games.

Every child will have a weekly guided reading session with an adult as well as daily phonics.

As stated, you will receive Year 1 keywords in the reading folder. These are to be kept at home to practice. We will be assessing these words with the children this week, if a word is highlighted it means that they are secure with that word.

Unfortunately we currently cannot send school library books home but if you have any books from Reception then please could you return them to us.
