


Maths:

In Maths, we will continue to pictorially represent numbers within 50. The children will also compare numbers within 50 by finding one more and one less than a given number using base 10. This week we have our Marvellous Maths session with a focus on Addition and Subtraction.

English:

In English, we will be listening and sequencing Handa's Surprise. The children will also be creating a new front cover and title before writing a sentence to innovate the story of Handa's Surprise.



Topic:

In Topic, we will be exploring our sense of 'Taste' by tasting a variety of different fruits from the story of Handa's Surprise. The children will also be creating a Valentines card to bring home.

W.O.W word of the week:

We will be sharing new vocabulary with the children that will support our learning in class. Can you use the word at home? We have sent home a template for you to share and display the word at home together.

We will be comparing our culture to the African culture in the story of Handa's Surprise.

'My Senses walk'


Can you go on a senses walk and record your five senses?

Science Fair!

We are excited to be taking part in this year's Primary Science Fair being run by Birmingham University and The Ogden Trust. The children have all been invited to participate by doing their own science project at home. The project can be an age appropriate experiment to answer a question or a problem, along with a solution, or it could be a research project. It can be on any area of science that interests your child. Projects need to be in school by Friday 22nd March and our School Science Fair will take place during the week of 25th March. A panel of judges will help to choose the best projects to represent the school at the Primary Science Fair to be held at Birmingham University on Thursday 4th April. The children who did these projects will have the opportunity of competing with other local primary schools to win a prize or award for their work and visit the University.



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


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
