This week we are learning:

- **Maths:** The children will be using a variety of representations to explore number bonds to 10. We will challenging ourselves to use the + and = sign correctly to write number facts to 10.
- **English:** We will be orally learning the text map for 'How to plant a seed'. The children will be building sentences by ordering words and using capital letters and full stops. We will also be introducing and applying the suffix 'ing' to root words.
- **Science:** The children will be identifying and comparing the differences between deciduous and evergreen trees. We will also be sorting a variety of garden and wild plants into groups.

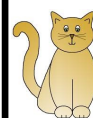


Creative learning at home (optional):
