
We are learning....





English:

In English, the children will be finishing their innovated version of 'How to plant a Turnip'. The children will then independently apply their suffix knowledge to re -write the instructions.

Maths:

The children will be consolidating their learning of Measure, through an Eggciting Easter themed Marvellous Maths! The children will be counting in groups of ten. We will be using lots of different manipulatives to support our counting and



recognise the pattern. We will also be exploring and identifying how to make equal and unequal groups.

Topic:

We will be ensuring our finished product meets our design criteria before we sell our clay plant pots. We will also be working scientifically to perform simple tests thinking carefully about our predictions and results.

RE day:

Our RE day is on Friday, the children will be looking at the significance of the Easter tradition to Christians and then comparing it to their own beliefs/ non-beliefs.
