In English this week, we have started a new topic based on the book 'Mr Big'. The children have learned a shortened version of this story (WAGOLL), using actions to help them remember! In Maths, we have been learning about division, using grouping and sharing to work out the answers. We have even moved on to using just our fingers to solve calculations!
