

Year Two Newsletter – Week Ending Friday 20thth March 2020

The Year Two teachers would firstly like to express how proud they are of all the children! During this unusual time, Year Two have been extremely sensible and have continued to make everyone smile – well done 2CA, 2A and 2J! This week, we have exposed the children to as much new learning as possible in Maths. We began the week by looking at time - o'clock, half past, quarter to, quarter past and five-minute intervals. The children then enjoyed making a clock to continue their time learning at home. In addition, we have explored measurement, focusing on length, height and capacity. We have learnt about different and appropriate units of measurement and have read differing scales. Finally, we have recapped our division skills and applied them to problems. Throughout the week, Year 2 have been learning useful techniques they can use when answering reading comprehensions, such as skimming and scanning for key information and underlining parts of the text. The whole year group have worked very hard this week so we thoroughly enjoyed some fun PE games and relaxing yoga in the afternoons.
