In English, our focus has been on the Ed Vere book 'Mr Big'. The children have practised using conjunctions to extend their sentences as well as learning about the different types of adverbs. They have sorted adverbs into when, where and how groups before using them as sentence openers. In Maths, we have been learning how to create and interpret both pictograms and block diagrams before completing a statistics test to finish this topic.
