## Homework:

MyMaths: Hopefully all children have managed to log onto MyMaths and complete the activities that have been set for them. As there are only a set amount of activities, there may be a duplication in activities. If this is the case, the children can try to beat their previous percentage and be able to keep practising the skills taught throughout the year.

Look, cover, write, check: Children should ensure they are practising the key words which we set weekly in their reading diaries. These can be done independently or with support.

Spelling Shed: Please ensure your child is logging onto Spelling Shed weekly to practise their weekly spellings.

Reading: Please ensure your child's reading diary is in school every day and they are reading for a minimum 3 x a week (I hour). This can be split up however you like. The book needs to be written in their diaries and signed by yourselves. Year 4 teachers check reading diaries on a Monday.

Poppies: Poppies are available to buy the week commencing 19.10.20. If the children would like to purchase a poppy, please could they bring the correct amount of money into school in an envelope or clear plastic bag. The paper poppies have a suggested donation of 20p. Other suggested donations are outlined in the photo below (see next page) but any donation would be welcomed – especially this year where their fundraising efforts have been thwarted somewhat and every penny will count.
