This week we started to look at our new story 'Billy the Brave Knight'. We have been practicing using expanded noun phrases, conjunctions and adverb openers in our writing, when describing the Goblin. In Maths, we have been finding 1/2, 1/4, and 1/3 of a shape, an amount and a set of objects. We have been practicing using our key language: denominator and numerator.
