Adding the suffix – ed

If a word ends in two consonants, just add – ed.

If a word ends in a short vowel sound a, e, i, o, u and a consonant, we double the consonant before adding – ed.

Homework:

The homework we set the children in Year 3 links to and supports the learning we do at school. Please ensure your child completes the following homework each week:

- Reading at least three times a week and log this in their Homework Logs
- Practising their six weekly spellings using the Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check section in their Homework Logs
- Logging into My Maths and completing the two tasks set
- Logging into Spelling Shed and completing the three spelling games

Homework Logs:

Your child needs to have their Homework Log in school every day. They will need them to complete quizzes, log their spelling results and for some Computing lessons. Homework logs should then go home each day so the children can access their homework using the logins at the back of the logs.
