

Dear parents,

On Thursday 12th July we have been lucky enough to be invited to Lickey Hills Primary School, (a school we work closely with) for a teddy's bear picnic and we have our planned trip to the Stratford-upon-Avon butterfly farm on Tuesday 10th. A busy and exciting week for the children. We are therefore asking for joint consent for both of these trips on one form!

During our lifecycles topic we will be reading stories about lifecycles of a butterflies and looking at the changes the egg goes through to become a butterfly. The trip will enable children to observe the different stages of butterflies' life through 'hands on' experiences. We will be involved in a guided tour through the farm by members of the butterfly farm staff, and will get up close with butterflies at the different stages in the lifecycle when in the cocoon, chrysalis, caterpillar and butterfly. We will also get the chance to see the insects in the insect room at the butterfly farm before going for a picnic in the park nearby (weather depending).

We will be leaving school at 9.10am and returning before the end of the school day. The children will need to wear their school uniform. Your son/daughter will need a packed lunch, including a drink, in a named disposable carrier bag please. Please do not pack peanut butter sandwiches or any items containing nuts in lunchboxes. If you would like school to provide a packed lunch for your son/daughter please indicate this on the slip below with the choice of ham, cheese or tuna sandwich they will also get an apple, a yoghurt and a biscuit.

In accordance with our Charging Policy we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £16, per pupil, to cover costs such as travel, entrance fees and insurance. Unfortunately, in some cases where there are insufficient contributions, we have to consider cancelling trips or events which we naturally try to avoid. Your contributions go a long way to helping us manage our school funds to ensure maximum value for every child, so thank you in anticipation of your ongoing financial support.
