<u>Year Six Residential Trip to Malvern Outdoor Elements</u> 22nd June – 26th June 2020 Dear Parents / Carers,

When our pupils enter Year Six, they are given the opportunity to participate in a residential visit, during which they undertake a range of outdoor and adventure activities. I am writing to you with details of this year's trip, which, as you probably know, will take place at Malvern Activity Centre.

We are really pleased to be taking the children to Malvern as our Coppice pupils always come back saying how much they enjoyed it.

The arrangements for Malvern this year are different to previous years. This year, due to the additional class in Year Six, the Malvern residential will be a three-day trip, rather than a five-day trip as it has been in previous years.

6L and half of 6G will stay on Monday and Tuesday night, and have half a day of activities on Wednesday; 6C and the other half of 6G will stay on Wednesday and Thursday night with half a day of activities on Friday. Further information about the logistics of this trip will be released closer to the time.

The full programme will be confirmed closer to the date. Likely activities include: rope courses, zip wire, abseiling, climbing, archery, kayaking, obstacle course and
