- Our class monkey George will receive an invitation to a wedding!
- He will show us the photos from the special celebration and tell us all about the bride and groom and what he saw. Have you ever been to a wedding? Can you talk about it? We would love to see a photo that you can share with the class.
- Writing wedding cards.
- In maths we will be learning how to use 10 frames for making different amounts.
- Matching a number with an amount by counting out the correct number of counters and making sure we fill our 10 frames correctly.
- Keyword games - trying to learn them confidently and off by heart.
- Reading and writing sounds to help our reading in phonics.
