



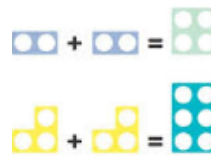
Reception: Our week ahead

Our week ahead – What are we going to be learning?

*Due to the different dates of our trip we will be learning certain things at different times over the next few weeks:*

- Discovering a suitcase in our classroom and working out where it is from – using the clues to help us.
- Looking at where China is on a globe and discussing how people get there.
- Learning about different ways of travelling.
- Talking about our airport visit and sequencing photos of our day. Talking about the most exciting parts of the day!
- Finding out about China and Chinese culture.
- What a passport is and how to take a passport style photo.
- Learning to use positional language and describe the position of items in comparison to others in the classroom.
- Controlling “Beebots” using directions.
- What double is e.g. double decker bus, double bed.
- Making doubles using objects and amounts.
