## Our week ahead – What are we going to be learning?

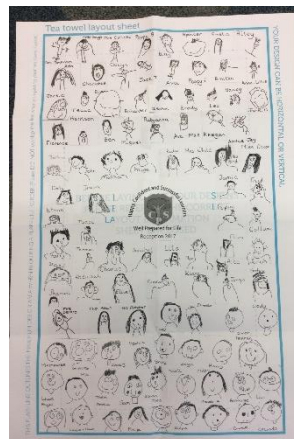
- Looking at art work by the famous Russian painter Kandinsky, saying what we like / don't like about it and why.
- Creating our own art work in the style of Kandinsky and talking about it.
- Which colours are primary colours and which are secondary colours. Exploring what happens when we mix colours together.
- Verbally learning the story of Mr Wiggle and Mr Waggle.
- Sequencing familiar events (our day, putting on our PE kit etc..) and using language related to time (first, next, after that and finally).
- To begin to practically count in 2's.
- Continuing to use the + and = signs when adding 2 sets together, writing our own number sentences forming our numbers correctly.
- Counting on from the larger number when adding on.
- Continuing to learn our keywords and trying to get to the next set!
