English:

In English, the children will continue to innovate their character description of their Wanted poster for the Giant. Children will begin to add the prefix—un to words, and to understand that this changes the meaning to the opposite;. E.G. Happy becomes unhappy.

Maths:

In Maths, we will continue to measure length and height using non-standard units of measure. The children will be using their hand and foot span to measure the playground and fence. We will also be building on this knowledge of measuring length and height and introducing a ruler and 'cm' as a standard unit of accurate measurement.

Topic:

In Topic, the children will be identifying and labelling the parts of a flower. We will be identifying the parts and their functions, before comparing them to a tree next week. The children will also be enjoying their visit from the 'Animal Lady' this week, and applying their prior knowledge to identify animal classifications.

Phonics homework:
