Homework:

Mathematics: The homework this week is on decimals. The children are expected to complete their homework for Monday. There is an example on the sheet of the methods we have practised in school. Spellodrome: The children are expected to achieve 500 points weekly. In addition to this, they are expected to complete the look, say, cover, write and cover tasks in their homework diary.

Reading: Children should continue to read at least three times per week; parents should denote all reading with a daily signature in your child's homework diary.

Some children also have additional comprehension sheet homework to help support their reading understanding.

Topic: There is no compulsory homework for topic. However, optional homework project can be completed at any point this half-term. Homework projects are due to be shared with the class on Friday 10th January. Furthermore, you could support your child's learning by reading, discussing and guizzing the content on the knowledge organiser.
