

Superheroes	
English	The children will continue to follow the RWI programme, focusing on securing their knowledge of sounds and applying them to their reading and writing. They will continue to secure their use of capital letters and full stops and develop their sentence composition.
Maths	*The children will be practising addition and applying their skills to the real-life concept of money (using real money) and looking at money calculations. *They will be learning to read 'o' clock and half past on an analogue clock.
Science	Not covered this half term.
Computing	The children will be learning to send emails to our Hero Helpers about important events in history. They will use 'Word' to practise and develop their typing skills.
History	The children will be travelling back in time to The Gunpowder Plot, The Great Fire of London and to the first Christmas. They will be investigating these events and writing about them. They key skills taught will be: to order events in history to know about the lives of important men, women and children from history. to understand why people did things and why events happened. to know that actions in the past make a difference to the future.
Geography	Not covered this half term.
Physical Education	The children will be exploring expression, gesture and movement in dance, inspired by bonfire night and the Great Fire of London.
Art and Design	The children will use a range of materials creatively. They will be exploring the painting style of Georges Seurat and apply it to their own design. They will be creating silhouetted skyline of the Great Fire of London. The children will be making a collage of a poppy for Remembrance Sunday.
Design and	Not covered this half term.
Technology	
Music	The children will be learning songs linked to the topic 'Superheroes'. The focus will be on keeping rhythm and beat.
Religious	The children will be learning about the religious festivals Hanukah
Education	and Christmas. They will role play the religious stories to help of their understanding.
PSHE	Weekly whole school assembly themes (see assembly themes) and relevant whole class THRIVE activities. We will also be thinking about the qualities in a real-life superhero and how we can be real-life superheroes too.
