Maths	<p>*The children will be developing their addition and subtraction skills by solving missing number problems.</p> <p>*They will be learning to double and halve numbers and shapes.</p>
Science	<p>The children will be learning to:</p> <p>*identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.</p> <p>*identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.</p>
Computing	The children will be learning to draw a picture of an animal and write about it using textease and Microsoft office programmes.
