World Restart a Heart Day

Tuesday 16th October was World Restart a Heart Day and adults and children from all over the world have been learning CPR (Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation).

All year 5 and 6 children and many of our staff had a training session delivered by Ali Spencer (a nurse, usually involved with training health care professionals). She explained that there were just six stages in potentially saving someone's life.

How do we do CPR?

- 1. Call for help. Is it safe to approach?
- 4. Call 999



Shake and shout for response





Repeat 5 and 6 until ambulance arrives

The children all had a practice at calling for help, doing chest compressions and administering rescue breaths. We're sure all the children will remember 30 compressions followed by 2 rescue breaths.
