Attendance awards

Two hundred and nine attendance badges have today been presented to those children who achieved 100% attendance for the summer term of the last academic year, representing a third of our children! Bronze, silver and 100% badges have all been given out depending on what the child achieved. Remember that a bronze star is for one term of 100% attendance last year; a silver is for two terms of 100% last year; and a 100% badge is for all three terms of 100%.

Everyone who has been presented with a badge can be rightly proud of their achievement - well done children!

For this term, children can continue to wear any bronze or silver stars that have been achieved as these are still current. However, any 'red' 100% badges from the 16-17 academic year can no longer be worn as there are now the new 100% badges to wear.

Once this term is over though, all bronze and silver stars will need to be removed as new bronze stars will be issued for children achieving 100% during this term and the reward system begins again. However, the new 100% badges can be worn for the entire year.

I am now looking forward to seeing how many children achieve a bronze 100% star for the autumn term and to presenting these at the start of the spring term after the Christmas holiday.

Don't forget too, that once again we will be running the 98% and above attendance year group reward for any children who achieve this level of attendance from the start of the academic year to the cut-off point at the end of the summer term.

E safety Workshop

O2 and the NSPCC have joined forces in their mission to help all children and their families in the UK stay safe online. Together, they're offering useful tools, support and guidance to help parents and carers have conversations with their children about their online lives. The NSPCC held a workshop on Wednesday for parents to become more aware of the safety messages that children receive in school in order to reinforce them at home and support children in making appropriate online choices.

On Wednesday this session was delivered to a number of Coppice parents and some important information and guidance was shared. If your child does see or do something online that worries them or yourselves, talk to your child and start a conversation to discuss how to stay safe online. Talking to your child regularly, and being part of their online world, will help you set and develop boundaries from an early age, meaning you can identify risks before they become issues.

During the e-safety parent workshop it became clear that parents find it difficult to keep track of what children are seeing online and making decisions about what apps or sites are appropriate for children. Visit NetAware.org.uk. This website will explain every game and app that your child might use, talking you through privacy settings, age restrictions, parental controls and potential risks.
