Homework Activity

This week we would like you to complete a counting activity! Depending on how confident you feel your child is at counting, you can choose which activity to complete.

Activity 1: Carefully count the spots on each ladybird to find out how many there are. When counting please encourage your child to point to each spot and say the number as they point to it (this helps to prevent them from rushing and making mistakes). When your child has counted the number of spots you could discuss what the numeral (digit) looks like and see if they can find it on the number line at the bottom of the page. If they would like an extra challenge they could write the correct number in each box!

Activity 2: Repeat the activity as above but this time ask your child to add one more spot to each ladybird and count how many spots there are all together. Discuss how the amount has now changed and that because a spot has been added that there are now more spots. Again, you could find the correct number on the number-line and write in in each box too!
