English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children will continue to follow the Read Write Inc. programme, focusing on securing their knowledge of sounds and applying them to their reading and writing. They will continue to secure their use of capital letters and full stops and develop their sentence composition. The children will be introduced to different writing styles and formats for example: poetry and letter writing.
Maths	<p>The children will be working on securing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the recognition of numbers to 20 (+beyond) securing their understanding of place value counting and ordering numbers addition and subtraction including missing number problems The children will be extending their understanding of 2D and 3D shapes
Science	Not covered this half term.
Computing	<p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve content.
History	<p>The children will be travelling back in time to The Gunpowder Plot, The Great Fire of London and to the first Christmas. They will be investigating these events and writing about them.</p> <p>The key skills taught will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> to order events in history to know about the lives of important men, women and children from history. to understand why people did things and why events happened. to know that actions in the past make a difference to the future.
Geography	Not covered this half term.
Physical Education	The children will be exploring expression, gesture and movement in dance, inspired by bonfire night and the Great Fire of London.
Art and Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children will use a range of materials creatively. They will be exploring the painting style of Georges Seurat and apply it to their own design. They will be creating silhouetted skyline of the Great Fire of London. The children will be making a collage of a poppy for Remembrance Sunday.
Design and Technology	Not covered this half term.
Music	<p>The children will be consolidating their understanding of Hip Hop and Rap from Autumn 1 as well as discovering Reggae music.</p> <p>This half term the children will be busy learning many different songs and dances for their annual nativity.</p>
Religious Education	The children will be learning about the religious festivals Diwali, Hanukah and Christmas. They will role play the religious stories to help of their understanding.
PSHE	<p>Weekly whole school assembly themes (see assembly themes) and relevant whole class THRIVE activities.</p> <p>We will also be thinking about the qualities in a real-life superhero such as courage, kindness and cooperation.</p>
